



At the primary level, the Teacher in charge listens to the problem in detail. If it is an academic matter, the faculty member of the concerned subject is consulted to sort out the case. If the situation demands, the Teacher in charge will also contact the parent/guardian/ hostel warden.</p>

The two members can avail the services of the Student Welfare Officer if needed. At The appellate level, the Principal and Vice Principal will redress all the unresolved cases in consultation with the College Council and the Director.</p> <p><b>Involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs / improvements</b></p> <p>Students are given proper guidance in studies. A group of 15 students are under the guidance of a faculty member. Academic and extra curriculum activities are under the guidance of the faculty member. Special classes are conducted in connection with university exams including the discussion of previous exam question paper. Frequent evaluations are done in academic matter. Week students are given special attention. Various departmental associations are there. They conduct seminars, classes. Feed back/ suggestions are taken from faculty and students and the suitable ones are implemented. Faculty members are</p>

encouraged to write course dairy. This course diary is audited by HOD and principal every semester.
